

Driver's licenses for Operations Area

Issue, revalidation and replacement of licenses (rules and policies) Driver's licenses shall only be issued to employees of companies that have formalized their contractual relationship with AICM, providing services to operations or aircraft, who hold a driver's license issued by the Ministry of Transport and Roads, as well as a current identification card authorizing platform access.

Anyone applying for a driver's license must attend and pass the diffusion course for rules of driving in the movement area.

- To renew movement area drivers' licenses, the client must respect and adhere to annual revalidation programs, in order to keep the register of authorized operators updated.
- It is the client's responsibility to report in writing the decommissioning of staff with drivers' licenses and to return the document for destruction.
- The operator is responsible for personally and promptly reporting the loss, theft or damage of the driver's license before the Administrative Unit that issued it, and for bringing an official report and initiating the replacement process.
- The client must cover the expenses incurred for the issue, revalidation, and replacement of driver's licenses for its staff. If the operator is an AICM member, they will only be subject to payment in case of replacement.
- The client must comply with training on equipment operation, as well as the services rendered by its operators.
- The operator must hold a current driver's license issued by the Ministry of Transport and Roads. To make vehicle insurance and liability effective.
- Without exception, NO driver's licenses will be issued if the cost of reissue for revalidation or replacement is not covered, or if the services provided by the company applying are interrupted on the recommendation of the legal area.
- No license shall be issued to an operator who has held one in another company and who upon their decommission has not returned the document for deactivation.
